Our Beavers have taken part in camps at Phasels Wood and Tolmers with activities such as Cresta Run, Caving, Open Fire Cooking and Camp Fire Songs. They have also been to Ninja Warriors, created Halloween crafts, played Wide Games, celebrated Chinese New Year, made scarecrows at Hammonds End Farm, night hikes, District Beavers Carol Concert and floated recycled boats down the River Lea.



Our Cubs have been camping at Tolmers (twice) and Lees Wood with Pioneering, Archery, Rifle Shooting, Open Fire Cooking, Camp Fire and songs. The Cubs have also been busy Raft Building, Hiking, Self-Defencing, Ringos at Hemel ski centre, Fire-Lighting, Lambing as Hammonds End Farm, Backwoods Cooking, Trebuchet Building, Canoeing, Bike Riding, Cubs Got Talenting, visiting Bayfordbury Observatory, Ice-Skating, Carol Singing for the Elderly and Christmas Card posting (more on that later).

Our Cubs also came second in the annual District Rothamsted Challenge.





Our Scouts had their week-long Summer camp on the Isle of Purbeck where they took part in Coasteering, Altar Fire Cooking, Sea Kayaking, Hiking and Wide Games on Brownsea Island. The Scouts have also been Fishing, Assault Coursing, Bike Riding, Learning to Sail, Go-Karting, Lambing at Hammonds End Farm, Ice-Skating, Collecting for a Food Bank and using their pioneering skills to construct a tripod bridge over the River Lea.



Our Scouts entered 5 teams in the annual County Green Beret competition, from our very youngest to our very oldest Scouts. With 148 teams competing 1st Harpenden retained two trophies achieving 3rd Place overall (we've had a top 3 finish for the sixth year in a row!). Our Scouts retained 1st place in the Night Bases and came both 1st and 2nd in the District. 
Awards
